## **Warning**

- 8. Store the device in a cool, dry, and dust-free environment.



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## **Getting Started**

#### To power on:

Press and hold the Power/Mode Button.

#### To power off:

Press and hold the Power/Mode Button.

#### **Overview**

To activate the camera, press the Power/Mode Button repeatedly to cycle through the various camera modes and settings. The modes will display in the following sequence:













	Settings	Modify camera settings.


## **Setting**













To access the settings menu, press the OK Button. Cycle through options by pressing the Power/Mode Button, then select the desired option using the Up/Down Buttons.

### **Video Settings**

## **Usage Guidelines**

#### Video Mode

- 1. To start recording, ensure the camera is in Video mode.
- 2. If the Video icon is displayed on the screen, press the OK Button to begin recording. A blue light will flash to indicate recording is in progress.
- 3. Press the OK Button again to stop recording; the blue light will stop flashing.

#### **Picture Mode**

- 1. To take a photo, ensure the camera is in Picture mode.
- 2. If the Picture icon is visible, press the OK Button to capture the image.

#### **Slow Motion**

- 1. To record in slow motion, switch to Slow Motion mode.
- 2. When the Slow-Motion icon appears, press the OK Button to start recording. The blue light will flash. Press the OK Button again to stop; the blue light will cease flashing.

#### Time-Lapse

- 1. Access Time-Lapse through the settings menu, then return to Video mode to begin.
- 2. Press the OK Button to start and stop time-lapse recording as indicated by the flashing blue light.

#### **Back & Front Screen Switching**

Long press the Down Button to switch between the back and front screens in video and photo modes. The back screen turns off upon switching to the front screen and vice versa.

#### **Playback**

- 1. To review content, ensure the camera is in Playback mode.
- 2. Use the Up/Down Buttons to navigate files and press the OK Button to play videos or photos.

#### **Battery Installation, Removal and Charging**

- 1. To install: Slide the battery cover as indicated by the arrow to open. Insert the battery according to the plus/minus orientation and ensure it's securely in place.
- 2. To remove: Push the battery cover to release and remove the battery.
- 3. To charge the device, you can:
- -Connect it to a computer or a power adapter.
- -Plug it directly into a car charger.
- -Charge while using the video function (requires driving mode to be activated).

#### **Indicator Lights**

- 1. Working Indicator: Blue light signals operation.
- 2. Charging Indicator: Red light flashes during charging and remains solid when fully charged.

#### **Connecting to HDMI**

Connect the camera to an HDMI-TV using an HDMI cable to display all operations on a high-definition screen.

### Connecting to a PC

When connected to a PC, turn on the camera to display three modes:

- 1. USB Mode: Press OK to enter for video and photo playback.
- 2. PC Camera: Press OK to use the camera function.
- 3. Charging Mode: Press OK to charge the device.

#### Wi-Fi Application Installation and Usage

To use Wi-Fi, install the "X-Sport Pro" app on your smartphone.

- 1. Scan the QR code or search for "X-Sport Pro" in the app store to download.
- 2. Android users can find it on Google Play; iOS users can find it in the App Store.

#### **Wi-Fi Connection Process:**

- 1. After powering on, long-press the Up button to display the Wi-Fi connection message.
- 2. Access the "X-Sport Pro" app to view the live feed, manage files, and adjust settings.

Note: App requires Android 4.1+/iOS 7+.
