

1. Wireless Bluetooth Function 1.1 Pairing Method: -Hold the power button for 3 seconds to activate pairing mode. indicated by the red and blue LED flashing alternately. -On your device, select the 'EUPHORA' headset to pair Successful pairing is confirmed when the LED stops flashing. -The connected device will display the Bluetooth icon and battery level, which varies by device.

1.2 Music Playback and Call Handling

-Press the play button once to start music playback: press again to pause. -Press the play button to answer calls and again to hang up. -Hold the play button for 2 seconds to reject an incoming call. -Double-press the play button to redial the last number. -Hold the play button for 2 seconds to activate the voice assistant when 200 - Gar connected. -For previous tracks, long-press the volume down button: a short press reduces volume. A "didi" tone plays when maximum volume is reached



-Long-press the next button for the next song; a short press increases volume.

-The power button activates with a long press of 3 seconds and turns off with a long press of 5 seconds.-The AUX port is used for wired listening by connecting an AUX cable to your device, which also turns Bluetooth off.



1.3 Charging Function:

-Connect the headset via USB to an adapter or computer to charge. The LED indicator will be red during charging and change to blue when fully charged.

-A voice prompt appears when the voltage is low.

1.4 TF Card Integration:

Engage the Bluetooth function and insert a TF card to automatically switch off Bluetooth. When the TF card is removed, Bluetooth reconnects. To toggle between TF and Bluetooth modes, press the "-" and "+" simultaneously.
